Comprehensive Exam Repeat Policy

- A. A student can re-take the exam at most three times (four attempts total).
- B. If a student failed only one subject (below 25 points if answering one question, or below 50 if two questions), then he/she can choose to re-take just that subject or the whole exam.
- C. If a student fails two subjects, while answering one question in each subject, he/she can choose to re-take two questions in one of the two failed subjects, or one question in each of them, or the whole exam.
- D. If a student fails two subjects, while answering two questions in one of them, then he/she needs to re-take the whole exam.
- E. The decision whether to re-take the whole exam or just some questions (and in what subjects) can be made at any time before the expiration of the allowed time for the repeated exam. To pass the exam, the student must receive a score of least 50% on the problems attempted.
- F. If a student is re-taking just one question, than the time allowed is 2 hours. In all other cases,
